I do not appear to have received a reply to my letters of the 2nd November and 18th December, 1934, which were addressed to you in regard to the steamers "BOMARSUND" and "HOGLAND", with a view to the attention of the Owner being called to the non-payment of certain accounts for surveys held on these vessels by the Society's Surveyors.

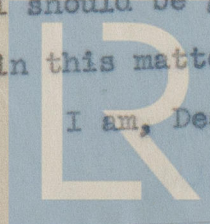
The account of Dan.Kr. 142.50, in the case of the steamer "HOGLAND" was paid to the Society's Surveyors at Copenhagen in January last. The account of Bel.Fcs. <sup>£19.12.0</sup> 2,745, for a survey held on the s.s. "BOMARSUND" at Antwerp in April/May, 1934, is still unpaid, and in view of the length of time it has been outstanding, I shall be much obliged if you will be so good as to bring the matter to the notice of the Owner and let me know what are his intentions in regard to payment.

The Boiler Survey on the s.s. "BOMARSUND" is considerably overdue, and I should be glad to learn what are the Owner's intention in this matter also.
