—Following received from Niton Wireless Station:—Following received from master of Finnish steamer BOMARSUND at 3 49 p.m.: Thick fog, being (? been) in collision with Latvian (? Estonian) steamer Stella, which sunk. Three hands lost. My ship considerably damaged. No leakage to holds.

—Following received from Niton Wireless Station:—Following intercepted from Spanish steamer Flora (EAEQ) at 4 53 p.m., G.M.T.: In lat. 49 45 N., long. 2 35 W., approximately, have seen wreck, dangerous to navigation, with three boats and one lifeboat submerged, named "Tallinn," at 3 20 p.m., G.M.T.

Following received from Niton Wireless Station:—Following received from Italian steamer Humanitas at 5 42 p.m., G.M.T.: At 4 30 p.m. passed near rest of wreckage, two lifeboats capsized in lat. 49 48 N., long. 2 43 W.
