It is submitted that providing two webs
24" x 18" be fitted on after side of bridge
be requested state whether it is intended
bulkhead in way of the hatch coamings
to extend the hatch coamings to the bridge
brackets be fitted on fore side of bulkhead
front retaining the sloping and coaming
at the height of the bulwark rail and the
arrangement as shown and amended (be carried
out to the Surveyor's satisfaction) the same will
merit allowance for the reduction in freeboard
admitted by the Tables for vessels of this type.

It is understood that the sloping hatch
end will be fitted as shown on the approved
profile and that only the hatch sides are
proposed to be extended to the bridge front.
