BRITISH SHIP SUNK

News has been received by the managers of the Newcastle steamer Akenside, which has been sunk off the Norwegian coast, that all the crew are safe.

The Akenside, owned by the Quayside Shipping Company, Limited, of Newcastle-on-Tyne, was a vessel of 2,694 tons, registered at Newcastle. The managers, Connell and Grace, Limited, of Newcastle and London, stated yesterday that they had received a telegram from Captain Nelson, the master, that he and the 26 officers and crew were all safe.
