S. With reference to Greenock report No. 17901 on the new steamer "DORICSTAR", I shall be obliged if you will kindly ascertain from the Surveyors and let me know whether the lengths of the sheerstrake doublings at the bridge ends and thickness of the intercostal top and bottom angles are as approved and the thickness of the tank top plating in the engine space is as approved or as shown on the plan of midship section as built, and not as stated on the report, and whether the amended size of the reversed frames has been approved, as these points are not clear.
