



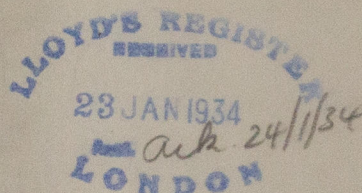

With reference to your letter of assignment dated 6th instant and to the Verification Report forwarded from this Office on 8th inst., we beg to state that :-

- (1) Two tarpaulins have been provided for each of the hatches on the shelter deck and one tarpaulin for each of the hatches on the freeboard deck.
- (2) All ventilator coamings have been placed in good order and to our satisfaction, and efficient means of closing has been provided where necessary.
- (3) Minor repairs have been effected to the side light glasses in the shelter 'tween decks and to the fastenings of the doors of all the machinery casings to our satisfaction.
- (4) Gauze has been provided for the openings of the airpipes from the oil fuel bunkers.
