

FREEBOARD REPORT on the

S.S. DORIC STAR.

It is submitted the Freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those ~~required by the tables~~ ^{corresponding to the scantlings}, merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, Subject to.

- (1) Two tarpaulins being provided for each of the hatches on the shelter deck, & one tarpaulin being provided for each of the hatches on the freeboard deck.
- (2) All ventilator coverings being placed in good order to the Surveyor's satisfaction & efficient means of closing being provided where this is not already the case.
- (3) Minor repairs being effected to the sidelight glasses in the shelter & main decks, & to the fastenings of the doors of all the machinery casings to the Surveyor's satisfaction.
- (4) gauge, or other efficient means of closing being provided for the openings of the air pipes from the oil fuel bunkers.

As directed by the Newcastle Surveyor the first entry ^{report} plans should be returned to them.
