Further to our submissions of the 7th and 14th instant, we have now been instructed to provide webs at No.6 hatchways on Upper and Second Decks, suitable for interchangeable plugs and brine grids. We accordingly submit for your approval plan in triplicate, shewing proposed arrangements to meet this requirement.

The webs approved for No.6 hatchway at Upper Deck are re-arranged, with reduced span, a further intermediate web being added. The existing webs at Second Deck hatchway will be removed and new webs spaced as shown, fitted in lieu.
