
We have been instructed to proceed with the fitting of steel gastight trunks round No.4 hatchways on second and third decks, these tween decks to be adapted for the carriage of chilled meat, and accordingly submit for your approval triplicate prints giving details of trunks and strengthening of beams and girders.

In view of the additional support afforded by trunk sides we trust that existing pillars in these tween decks may be retained.

Existing openings for vent trunks, trimming hatches, etc., in second and third decks will be plated over. Solid cement shell chocks will be fitted at second and third decks or existing shell chocks renewed in cement if found necessary after removal of insulation.

We trust you will give these further proposals your early consideration to allow us to proceed with this work without delay.
