Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 9th instant enclosing plans, in triplicate, of additional oil fuel pumping arrangement in the machinery space and No.6 hold of the s.s. "DORIC STAR", and have to acquaint you that these plans will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon, the remaining requirements of Sections 20 and 34 of the Rules (1933-4) be complied with so far as they are applicable, and all the work be done to your entire satisfaction.

It is noted that the oil fuel bunkers overflow to the cofferdams in the double bottom situated between floors Nos. 82 and 84 and in view of the small capacity of this compartment, it is suggested that an alarm device should be fitted to the final overflow pipe leading to the cofferdam.

Two sets of the plans are returned herewith.
