Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant in connexion with the oil fuel bunkers of the S.S. "DORIC STAR", and to acquaint you in reply that it is considered the width of cofferdam proposed, viz. 21 inches, will not permit of reasonable access for examination of the oiltight bulkhead.

In the circumstances I think it well to suggest that this question is one which should be discussed with the Society's local Surveyors, who will require to carry out the work of testing the new tanks, with a view to determining the minimum practicable width of this space. It is thought, however, that it should not be less than one frame space.
