We submit for your approval prints in triplicate shewing new oil bunkers in No.6 Hold. This submission as you will note is a preliminary to further details which will be forwarded immediately they are completed.

We wish at this stage to obtain your approval of our proposal to cut out completely the 3rd deck in No.6 Hold, leaving brackets three frame spaces in length, port and starboard at each end of hold, also your approval of our proposed suggestion to cut away the reverse frame in way of new oiltight flat, fitting angle collars round main frame and attachment of reverse frame to flat.

We would be glad if you would favour us with your comments on these specific items at the earliest possible moment to enable us to proceed immediately with the removal of deck and cutting of reverse frames at ship.
