M. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant enclosing plans, in triplicate, of profile and side stringers, fore end shell plating, forecastle and upper decks, second and third decks, and Nos. 196, 204 & 209 bulkheads, in connexion with the proposal to fit a Maier form bow to the S.S. DORIC STAR", and the contents have been duly noted.

The case has been discussed in this Office with your Mr. Champness, and I have pleasure in stating that provided the arrangements be carried out as shewn and amended on the plans and to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the same will be approved.

It is observed that you state that chilled meat will be hung from the third deck beams in No. 1 hold, but I may say that, after discussion with the Owners, Mr. Champness stated that this would not be done.

Two copies of each of the plans in question are returned herewith, and the remaining copies are being retained for reference.


It is noted that plans shewing the proposal to fill in the forward and after wells will be forwarded later.
