Further to our letter of the 4th ultimo, respecting a proposal to fit "Maier Form Bow to the above steamer, incidentally lengthening the vessel 18' on the waterline, we now have a telegram from the Owners asking us to look into the question of filling in the fore and after wells. This further modification is shown on the attached outline profile of the vessel. The scantlings we propose would be similar to those obtaining in the existing erections, no topsides strengthening being contemplated.

As this matter is very urgent we are looking into the question of cost with all possible haste and to enable us to deal promptly with this we should be glad if you would favour us, at the earliest possible moment, with an indication of the increase in equipment you would be prepared to approve in the event of this alteration being carried out.
