R. I duly received your letter of the 10th instant respecting the steamer "ANTONIOS VRONDISSIS", and having submitted the case to the Committee, I am directed to acquaint you that, in all the circumstances, it has been decided to make a record of "Stranded 8,36 - Refloated - Now in port damaged" against the vessel's name in this Society's Register Book, and at the same time to expunge her class in accordance with the usual practice.

In view of the above decision the International Load Line Certificate issued by this Society to the ship is no longer valid, and I shall be obliged if you will be good enough to return the same, and the certified copy, to this Office for cancellation.
