ANTONIOS VRONDISIS. — London, Aug. 6.—A cable received by the agent of the owners of the Greek steamer Antonios Vrontdis from the master states that the vessel grounded near Kem in the White Sea and was flooded and subsequently sank. A salvage agreement has been signed on the U.S.S.R. Arbitration Commission Form "no cure no pay."

ANTONIOS VRONDISIS. — Archangel, Sept. 19.—Steamer Antonios Vrontdis is partly discharged only and has been lying full of water on a sandbank in the river here during the last weeks. The harbour master states that the floating dock is so occupied that they cannot rectify the Antonios Vrontdis during this season. The vessel will, therefore, only be removed to a sheltered place, where she must remain over the winter. The harbour master also states that the bottom damage is extensive and that, when the steamer was brought here, the divers found a large stone in the hold, which had been pressed through the bottom at the stranding place.—Salvage Association.
