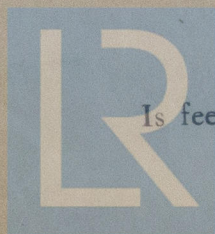
The freeboard marking has been verified and found to agree with the freeboards given on certificate No. 5826 dated 5th February, 1934. which is returned herewith.
