CABO CULLERA.—London, June 21. —
In reply to inquiry, Lloyd's Agents at
Tarragona write under date of June 13:
The Spanish steamer Cabo Cullera,
which was sunk on Jan. 14 last, during
an air attack, is still in port. The vessel
is in very bad condition and is very
old, so that there is no hope of being
able to put her afloat, and it will be
necessary to destroy her.

Date of Casualty 14th January 1939.

Précis of particulars of Casualty Lloyd's Agents at Tarragona reported
on the 13th June that this vessel was sunk by aircraft
on the 14th January, 1939. She is in a very bad
condition and is very old. There is no hope of
refloating her and it will be necessary to destroy her.
