H. I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 30th ultimo relative to the steamer "CABO CULLERA", and have to acquaint you that the Committee have today had this case under their consideration in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the 5th Special Survey No.1 has now expired. It is noted from your memorandum that the vessel is still laid up at Tarragona, and I shall be glad if you will explain to the Owners that in such cases it is the Committee's usual practice to require Owners to furnish an undertaking to carry out all overdue surveys before the vessel again goes into commission.

The Committee concluded the Owners will have no objection to doing so in this instance, and I enclose a printed form of undertaking which I shall be glad if you will arrange to be signed and returned to this Office in due course. A duplicate copy of the form is also enclosed for the Owners' filing purposes.
