I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly, and obtain from them, and forward to this Office, a letter intimating that they will have this done.

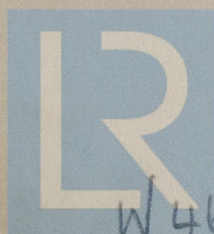
