H. I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had under consideration ~~today~~ a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Bilbao in which they state they have been informed by your goodselves that the steamer "CABO CULLERA" is laid up at that port indefinitely and that you do not contemplate carrying out the 4th Special Survey N°2, which became due at the end of April last, unless the vessel is again placed in commission.
