Dear Sir,

In reply to the inquiries made in the classing letter of 27th September relating to Kobe Rpt.No.3265 on the steamer "IWATESAN MARU", I wish to say that Mr. House and Mr. Fry who surveyed the vessel during construction are not now at this port but upon inquiry of the Builders it appears that the upper deck stringer plate is fitted 46 x .46 and not as stated in the report. Without access to the anchor Certificate, carried on board, the Certified Test of the Stream Anchor cannot be ascertained but it appears probable that the entry in the report is a clerical error.

The length of the double bottom in the boiler space is 21'- 3". The journals do not record the test of this part (No.3) of the double bottom; only Nos.1,2,4,5 & 6 being named as tested.
