I am writing to you in connection with the proposed merger of the Register of Companies and the Register of Companies (Overseas) which is being considered by the Department of Trade and Industry. The Register of Companies (Overseas) is a register of companies which are incorporated in other countries but which have a substantial interest in the United Kingdom. It is proposed that the Register of Companies and the Register of Companies (Overseas) should be merged into a single register. This would be a significant step towards the simplification of the company law framework and the reduction of the administrative burden on companies.
