Sir:

In reply to your classing letter of the 9th June, Baltimore report No. 1896, S. S. "Munplace". We have to inform you that water Ballast will be carried in all double bottom tanks, with the exception of the Tank under the Boilers which is 22'-0" long & has been tested with water but all manhole doors removed after testing. This tank has no holes through Tank Margia to the bilges; but has a suction fitted to the ballast Manifold.
