I duly received your letter of the 19th instant respecting the Motorship "PIONER", and in confirmation of my cablegram, as per translation attached, I have to say that as this vessel was last examined in drydock more than 2½ years ago when the inspection was only for the purpose of making out a specification of repairs for a large number of indented plates and leaky cargo tanks, the Committee must insist upon the requirements as to drydocking, being complied with if the vessel is to proceed on her proposed voyage for breaking up as a classed ship.
