Survey

The requirements of a Special Survey No. 3 have been partly complied with.

The Oslo Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and the requirements of Special Survey no. 3 completed.


The machinery for the herring factory has been removed and whale oil apparatus fitted on main deck under extended flensing deck.

An additional deep tank for carrying whale oil has been fitted in accordance with an approved plan.

The bridge deck has been reduced 16 feet in length at the fore end, a coal hatch fitted in accordance with approved plans and alterations effected to deck house, foremast and minor alterations carried out.

The Surveyors recommend that some indented plates in H strake on starboard side be dealt with at the Owners' convenience.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed
