
Sirs,

I return herewith two copies of the plan,

forwarded with your letter of the 26th ult., showing the structure proposed to be fitted in the forward well of the vessel "GROSHOLM", and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shown and to your satisfaction, they will be approved.

I have to inform you that the erection has been considered on the basis of its being a light covering for the boiler &c., and that the scantlings and arrangements, including the riveting of the end laps, could be approved on that basis. Your attention, however, is drawn to the fact that if this will have to support any local weights of appreciable magnitude, you should satisfy yourselves that the scantlings of the deck and of the side plating and frames are sufficient for purpose.

I have also to acquaint you that the equipment changes, and if the figure 1 is desired to be retained, the equipment should be in accordance with or equivalent to the requirements of the Rules.
