

Dear Sirs,

I return herewith two copies of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 26th ultime, shewing the existing structure proposed to be fitted in the forward well of Motor Vessel "GROSHOLM", and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shown and to your satisfaction, they will be approved.

I have to inform you that the erection has been ordered on the basis of its being a light covering for the outer boilers &c., and that the scantlings and arrangements, including the riveting of the end laps, could be approved on that basis. Your attention, however, is drawn to the fact that if this structure will have to support any local weights of appreciable magnitude, you should satisfy yourselves that the scantlings of deck and of the side plating and frames are sufficient for purpose.

I have also to acquaint you that the equipment changes, and if the figure 1 is desired to be retained, the equipment should be in accordance with or equivalent to requirements of the Rules.
