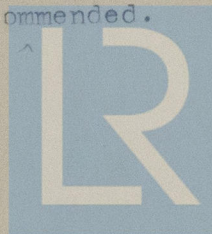

The Oslo Surveyors report this vessel placed in a floating dock, bottom cleaned and coated and on account of damage through cause not stated, 1 shell plate has been repaired, windlass and steam winches overhauled, repairs to bulwark and minor repairs carried out.

The vessel is stated to have lost a bower anchor and the Surveyors recommend a bower anchor be placed on board on the vessel's arrival in the U.K. from Norway.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 12,33 subject as recommended.
