Surveyors should note that there is only one valid certificate, and the above endorsement should be made thereon. No entry should be made on a certified copy of the certificate unless the original certificate has been produced to and endorsed by the Surveyor.

It is submitted the Surveyor be informed that the Society is not authorized to carry out annual surveys on Norwegian ships.

If a survey equivalent to an annual survey is requested by the captain the same should be certified in a separate form and not on the Freeboard Certificate.

As there is no provision for an annual endorsement on the Freeboard Certificate he should state the actual working used by him and where the endorsement was made.
