Re. 350 BHP. Diesel Polar Engines, Skm, Reports No. 2510, 2511 & 2512.

At a visit yesterday by the works Manager of the Stockholm Diesel Factory, this Gentleman pointed out that, at the endurance tests of these engines, the BHP. at the engine, dealt with in my Report no. 2510, was found to be 363,3 and of the two engines, dealt with in Reports no. 2511 and 2512 also upwards of 360.

These engines, as a consequence, have been sold to the German and Norwegian Owners as 360 BHP Engines, and Mr. Randers, the Works Manager, above mentioned, intimated to me, that the Owners insisted of having the BHP., recorded in the certificates, altered to 360 BHP.. I complied to Mr. Randers' request by issuing new certificates instead of these, previously issued, which have been handed back to this Office.
