Referring to your letter of yesterday's date, I have to state that as indicated in my First Entry Report four hatch beams were fitted to each hatch in the above ship.

The beams were of the joist type **I** 16' x 6" x 62 lbs. per lineal foot and were spaced 6'-6", 6'-6", 4'-0", 6'-6" & 6'-6" to suit stowage of paper rolls.

The latest type of steel stamped, angled, battening cleat was fitted all round each hatch spaced 24" apart & 6" from hatch covers. Two tarpaulins were fitted to each hatch.
