

ALEXANDER RODGER RIDDELL will say :-

I am a Ship and Engineer Surveyor to Lloyd's Register of Shipping and employed in the Newcastle district.

I surveyed the machinery of the M.V. "JOSEPH MEDILL" for classification purposes.

I produce my Report of Survey No. 92860, dated the 20th August, 1935, giving particulars of the machinery and auxiliary machinery.

The machinery was constructed under special survey in accordance with the Rules of the Society and in accordance with plans approved by the Society. The material and workmanship were good. The machinery was tested under working conditions and found to be satisfactory.

I recommended that the vessel was eligible to have the record of *L.M.C. (Lloyd's Machinery Certificate) August, 1935, and notation T.S.C.L. (Tail shaft continuous liner).
