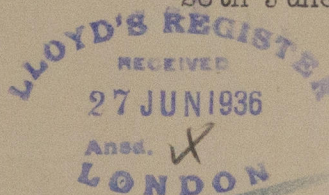

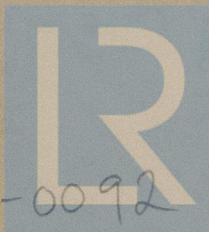
Thank you for your letter of yesterday's date enclosing a set of copies of the First Entry Reports on this vessel.
