I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant, requesting particulars of the welded ship which left the Tyne over a month ago, and has not been reported since.

In reply I would say that the name of this vessel is the "JOSEPH MEDILL", full particulars of which will be found in the Society's Register Book, under No. 38652 in the Supplement.

I accordingly attach hereto an extract from the Register Book which gives the particulars you desire.

I think it well to point out that as the particulars from the Register Book show, this vessel was classed by this Society for restricted service and therefore the class was not in operation while she was making the journey from this country in open waters.

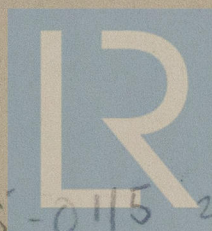
prepared for the voyage under the supervision of the Board of Trade, who issued a certificate allowing her to make the contemplated journey.
