Nature of Survey .....

The 1st S.S.No.2 has been held on the hull.

The Vancouver Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock and the bottom cleaned and coated.

On account of damage through encountering heavy weather two shell plates on starboard side in way of No.4 double bottom tanks fitted with doublings, a number of shell and intercostal rivets renewed and minor repairs effected.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 9,35.
