Dear Sirs,

With reference to the Third Special Survey No. 1 which became due at the end of June last on the steamer "OINOUSIOS", I have to acquaint you that the Committee deferred action in regard to this inspection as the Owners stated that on the vessel's arrival in the Mediterranean they would decide whether to carry out the special survey or sell the vessel to ship breakers.

I am now informed by the London Representatives of the Owners that this vessel is leaving Antwerp today for Stettin to load for Italy, and that after the discharge of her cargo she is to proceed to Spetzziato be handed over to Italian Shipbreakers.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will keep the case in mind and advise me promptly as soon as the work of demolition is commenced.
