Dear Sir,

F. With reference to your letter of the 29th ultimo respecting Messrs. Deutsche Werft Yard Nos. 201-204, I have to inform you that Sec., 29 2(c) (2) of the Society's Rules required "scupper pipes from superstructures which have temporary closing appliances at the forward end are to be led overboard and fitted with storm valves or some other approved appliances".

Non-detachable screw plugs are accepted as equivalent appliances and therefore the storm valves may be dispensed with in the discharges referred to, provided the requirements of the Rules as indicated above be complied with. The Builders' proposal to provide hand cocks to the sanitary discharges below the wash hand basins and non-detachable screw-down plugs to the scuppers at the freeboard deck from the enclosed spaces within the poop will be approved.
