I am in receipt of your letter of the 23rd instant, with plans, in triplicate, advised therein of piping arrangement in tanks and pump room proposed for Messrs. Deutsche Werft A.G., Yard Nos. 201-4, and I have to inform you that these plans will be approved provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon, and the remaining requirements of the Rules (1937-8) be complied with so far as they are applicable.


With reference to the cargo pump discharge overboard, I have to point out that if the outlets of the pipes at the shipside plating are not provided with bolted blank flanges, shut-off valves should be fitted at the shipside.
