Dear Sir,

In view of the difficulty in obtaining suitable material at the present moment Messrs. Deutsche Werft propose to use for the La Mont donkey boilers to be constructed by them for their Yard Nos. 198 to 205 headers of 70/110 mm and 100/140 mm diameter respectively made from material having an ultimate tensile strength of <sup>31.5 38 ton</sup> 50 - 60 kgs/mm<sup>2</sup> with a minimum elongation of 18%. These boilers will be similar in design as the boilers which have previously been constructed by Messrs. Deutsche Werft and these boilers are to have a boiler pressure of 12 kgs/cm<sup>2</sup>.

Messrs. Deutsche Werft request to be informed whether the Committee will be agreeable to headers made of the material mentioned above being used in the case of these boilers. As the matter is very urgent please cable your decision to this Office. at your earliest convenience.
