I am in receipt of your letter of the 21st instant respecting the crankshaft ordered by Messrs. M.A.N., Augsburg, from Messrs. Gutehoffnungshutte, Sterkrade, for Messrs. Deutsche Werft's Yard Nos. 201 or 202, and have to say it is noted that this crankshaft is not fitted with dowel pins and that the shrinkage allowance has been found to be from 1/550 to 1/535 of the diameter, and this is in order provided the yield point of the material of the crank webs is not less than 50% of the ultimate tensile strength.
