Dear Sirs,

M. I am returning to your address, under separate cover, two copies of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 27th ultimo, of oiltight transverse bulkheads shewing a proposal to arrange the seams of the plates within the longitudinal bulkheads horizontally in the case of Messrs. Deutsche Werft's Yard Nos. 201-204, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shewn and to your satisfaction they will be approved.

As these vessels are practically sister ships to the same Builders' No. 181 ("NUEVA GRANADA"), the plans of which are at present in your Office, I shall be glad if you will be so good as to forward in the case of future submissions of plans for the new vessels the corresponding approved plans of the "NUEVA GRANADA".

The remaining copy of the plan is being retained for record.
