With reference to your classing letter of the 12th inst. respecting the case of the m.v. "INVERDARGLE" Hamburg first entry report No. 22865, I have to state that the electric welding has been employed to the double bottom and motor seating as shown on the approved plan.


The horizontal Stringers I and II of the transverse oil tight bulkheads are connected to the longitudinal bulkheads by electric welded flat bars instead of the T iron connection. The electrodes used are approved by the Committee and comply with the Regulations and Test set forth in Section 4 clause 7.
