Dear Sir,

We are in receipt of your letter of the 11th instant regarding the freeboard report on the steamer "SIMON BOLIVAR", Yard No. 138, and with regard thereto I beg to propose that this vessel, also in dealing with the freeboard might be looked upon as a complete super structure deck vessel, as the Owners have made the openings in the forepart with a view to ventilation when trading in the West-Indies, and when not loaded to her freeboard marking. It will therefore be most difficult where the whole of the deck is continuous, to explain to them that this case will have to be dealt with under well-deck vessels and I should be very much obliged if you will be good enough to look into this case immediately and to indicate on the enclosed plan what additional manner you would propose to look upon the closing of these openings as a permanent measure.

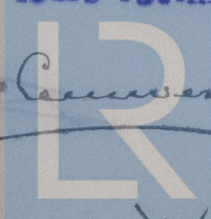
