Nature of Survey Condition and alterations

The Amsterdam Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated, repairs to <sup>port house pipes renewed</sup> (as per attaching approved plan) and minor repairs effected.

Small fractures at upper edge of sheerstrake at port of deckhouse have been repaired by electric welding and the Surveyors recommend the repair be specially examined at the next dry docking. alterations have been effected to the Promenade Deck and deckhouse in front of it in accordance with the attached plan.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classified with record of survey 738 <sup>subject as recommended, approved plan.</sup> as recommended.
