Dear Sir,

Referring to your letter M. of the 28th ultimo returning one plan of the steamer "SIMON BOLIVAR", in connexion with the Owners' proposals to extend the promenade deck aft and to fit an extended deck house on top of same, we beg to inform you that the Owners have now submitted an amended plan, in triplicate, which is being forwarded to you for your consideration, together with the plan referred to above.

From this amended plan you will observe that stiffeners of 75 x 50 x 7 will be fitted with a view to lack of space in the cabins, instead of stiffeners of 90 x 50 x 7 as indicated on the plan previously approved.

The Owners kindly requested whether this proposal could be approved.

Will you be good enough to return two copies of the plan when dealt with, at your earliest convenience.
