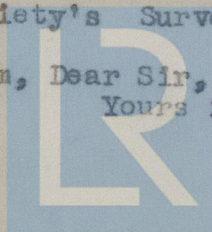
With reference to my letter of the 24th instant and the conversation over the telephone on that date relative to the completion of the survey for the assignment of Convention freeboards to the steamer "ATTIKOS", I have to inform you I am now in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff in which they state that they have been advised by your local Representative that as the ship was urgently required he obtained permission from the Board of Trade to proceed for a short voyage to the Mediterranean on the old freeboard certificate.

It is understood that the survey for the issue of the Convention freeboard certificate will be completed on the vessel's return to the United Kingdom and in this connexion I shall be obliged if you will be good enough to advise me in due course at what port the matter will receive attention in order that the Society's Surveyors may be advised.
