Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you I am advised by the Owner of the steamer "ATTIKOS" that he desires to complete the Convention freeboard survey of this ship at your port at the present time.

In this connexion I have to state that the freeboards indicated on the enclosed memorandum were assigned subject to the fore and afters being in accordance with the Regulations. It was reported that these were in one length and the Owner was informed that they can be accepted provided chocks are fitted on the hatch beams as required.

It is understood that Mr. Law, of Messrs. Ferguson and Law, will be present at the survey.

I shall therefore be glad if you will give the case attention and you should see that the fore and afters and their bearing surfaces and chocks on the beams are in accordance with the requirements and should report particulars of the same to this Office.

The lettering of the markings should be amended to correspond to Greek Law.

A Greek freeboard certificate and copy will be forwarded to you tomorrow.
