Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant relative to the issue of a freeboard certificate in respect of the steamer "ATTIKOS" and in reply have to inform you that no report has yet been received at this Office from the Society's Surveyors as regards compliance with the condition of assignment or the marking and verification of the Convention freeboards. In this connexion I beg to remind you that Mr. Polychroniadis called at this Office on the 14th August last when it was arranged with him that the fore and afters could be accepted as they extend in one piece for the entire length of the hatchway, but that chocks would be fitted on the beams as required. It was understood that this Office would be advised as to when and at what port the survey would be completed but no further news has been received.

In the circumstances I shall be obliged if you will let me know what arrangements are proposed to be made in the matter in order that the Society's Surveyors may be instructed.
