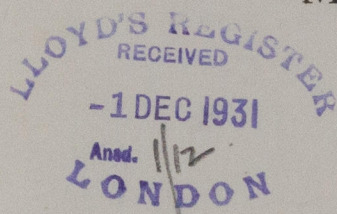

We return herewith freeboard certificate for the s.s. "ATHANA" ex "ATHENIC" and regret to say that the sale of this steamer to the Firm represented by Mr. J.D. Rossolymos, has not materialised, and, the name not having been changed as reported by us, the vessel should be reinstated in the Register Book under her old name of "ATHENIC".

We understand that several writs have been issued against the ship, including one on behalf of Messrs. Smith's Dock Co., for cost of repairs and docking, and, on the order of the Court, the steamer will be offered for sale by Messrs. C.W. Kellock at public auction on the 15th proximo.

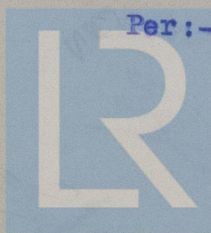
